Our world is in crisis.

The existential threats to humanity and to all life are legion:



Throughout history, humans have made great strides in technological development. Yet our moral capacities have scarcely evolved. We are dangerously lacking in altruism and fair-mindedness, and so tragically unable to meet the moral challenges of our times.

What is Virtumax™?

Why altruism?
